- It is understood and agreed that the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted 01/01/22 and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions", adopted 01/01/24, prepared by the Department of Transportation, shall govern insofar as they may be applied and insofar as they do not conflict with the special provision and supplemental specifications attached hereto.
- It is understood that quantities listed are approximate only and that they may be increased or decrease as may be needed to properly complete the improvement within its present limits or extensions thereto, at the unit prices stated and that bids will be compared on the basis of total price bid for each group.
- Delivery in total or partial shipments as ordered shall be made within the time specified in the special provisions or by the acceptance at the point and in the manner specified in the "Schedule of Prices". If delivery on the job site is specified, it shall mean any place or paces on the road designed by the awarding authority or its authorized representative.
- The contractor and/or local public agency performing the actual material placement operations shall be responsible for providing work zone traffic control, unless otherwise specified in this proposal. Such devices shall meet the requirements of and be installed in accordance with applicable provisions of the "Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" and any referenced Illinois Highway Standards.

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- 5. Each pay item should have a unit price and a total price. If no total price is shown or if there is a discrepancy between the product of the unit price multiplied by the quantity, the unit price shall govern. If a unit price is omitted, the total price will be divided by the quantity in order to establish a unit price. A bid will be declared unacceptable if neither a unit price nor a total price is shown.

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The following Special Provision supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted

January 1, 2022, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures of Materials" in effect on the date of invitation of bids, and the Supplemental Specification and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included here in which apply to and govern the construction of the above named section, and in case of conflict with any parts, or parts of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

**TOTAL GROUP BIDS:** Bidder is required to bid both Group 1, Group 2, Group 3 and Group 4. Low bidders will be determined by the lowest total of the extension of both Group 1, Group 2, Group 3, and Group 4.

**CM 150 AGGREGATE MIXTURE MIXING (SPECIAL) AND CM 300 AGGREGATE MIXTURE MIXING (SPECIAL):** This work shall include supplying the CM150 and CM 300 in the quantities specified. This work shall also consist of furnishing a portable pug mill with operator and an adequate number of wheeled end loaders with operators to adequately produce and stockpile a bituminous aggregate mixture to the satisfaction of the Highway Commissioner. The portable pug mill must be capable of mixing a minimum of 300 tons of aggregate and 3000 gallons of CM-150/CM-300 per hour. The pug mill must have two hoppers so that two different aggregate gradations may be blended for the mix. All aggregate will be supplied by Monticello Road District. All pugging activities shall take place at the Monticello Road District shop. Monticello Road District will provide one wheeled end loader and operator to assist the contractor with loading aggregate into the pug mill. All items necessary for this work shall be paid for at the contract unit price per gallon of CM-150/CM-300 used.

**BITUMINOUS AGGREGATE MIXTURE PLACING (SPECIAL):** This work shall consist of placing and rolling the Bituminous Aggregate Mixture with a self propelled spreading and finishing machine (paver) equipped with electronic grade control and a 30' ski. The material shall be placed no later than seven days after the Bituminous Aggregate Mixture was made. The paver shall be capable of spreading the material to a width of 20 feet in a single pass. The roller to be used for this project shall be a tandem, steel wheel roller, weighing 6 to 10 tons. Monticello Road District will load and haul the Bituminous Aggregate Mixture from the stockpile location to the contractors paver. After a portion of the Mixture has been placed and the roller has made one static pass, a blotter aggregate (CA 16) shall be spread over the surface of the Mixture. Monticello Road District shall supply and place the blotter aggregate (CA 16). Immediately after the blotter has been applied, the Contractor shall roll the placed mixture a second time in a manner as directed by the Engineer. The Contractor shall be responsible for rolling the placed mixture on the second and third day after the mixture has been place in a manner acceptable to the Highway Commissioner. Monticello Road District will provide all necessary traffic control for this project. All items necessary for this work shall be paid for by an hourly rate with no additional compensation. It is estimated that the placement portion of this project will take twelve (12) hours to complete. The contractor should bid based on the estimated time of twelve (12) hours but will be paid for actual hours of paving.

**PREVAILING WAGE RATES:** This contract calls for the delivery and installation of a public work, with the meaning of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/.01 et seq. ("the Act"). The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers, workers and mechanics performing services on public works projects no less than the current "prevailing rate of wages" (hourly cash wages plus amount for fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed. The Illinois Department of Labor revises the prevailing wage rates and the contractor/subcontractor has an obligation to check the Department's web site for revisions to prevailing wage rates.
