It is understood and agreed that the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted April 1, 2016, and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions", adopted January 1, 2021, prepared by the Department of Transportation, shall govern insofar as they may be applied and insofar as they do not conflict with the special provisions and supplemental specifications attached hereto.
2. It is understood that quantities listed are approximate only and that they may be increased or decreased as may be needed to properly complete the improvement within its present limits or extensions thereto, at the unit price stated and that bids will be compared on the basis of the total price bid for each group.
3. Delivery in total or partial shipments as ordered shall be made within the time specified in the special provisions or by the acceptance at the point and in the manner specified in the "Schedule of Prices". The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", Adopted January 1, 2021 _____, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures of Materials" in effect on the date of invitation of bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included here in which apply to and govern the construction of 21-01000-00-GM to 21-08000-00-GM _____, and in case of conflict with any part, or parts, of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

EQUIPMENT: Contractors who are bidding on Group 6, Group 7, or Group 8 must use a distributor with a minimum capacity of 2,800 gallons and be able to apply the material to a width of 24 feet in a single pass.

PREQUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS: No proposal will be accepted from any Contractor wishing to bid on Group 6, Group 7, or Group 8 contained herein, unless they have been certified as an approved bidder as required by the Illinois Department of Transportation. They must furnish the Piatt County Highway Department a "Certificate of Eligibility" issued by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

PREVAILING WAGE RATES: This contract calls for the delivery and installation of a public work, with the meaning of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/.01 et seq. ("the Act"). The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers, workers and mechanics performing services on public works projects no less than the current "prevailing rate of wages" (hourly cash wages plus amount for fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed. FOR
BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT (CLASS A-1, A-2, A-3) FOR LOCAL LETTINGS

Effective: June 16, 2017

Revised:

All references to Sections and Articles in this Special Provision shall be construed to mean specific Sections and Articles in the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction adopted by the Department of Transportation.

Revise Articles 403.15 and 403.16 to read:

403.15 Method of Measurement. Measurement of the volume of asphalt binders, emulsified asphalts, rapid curing liquid asphalt, medium curing liquid asphalts, slow curing liquid asphalts, asphalt fillers, and road oils will be based on the volume of the material at 60 °F (15.6 °C). Volumes measured at higher or lower temperatures will be corrected to the volume at 60 °F (15.6 °C) using the Standard ASTM-IP Petroleum Measurement Tables, ASTM D 1250.

Payment will not be made for bituminous materials in excess of 105 percent of the amount specified by the Engineer.

When bituminous materials are delivered by tank truck from a refinery or from a storage tank, a weight ticket for each truck load shall be furnished to the inspector. The ticket shall show the weight of the empty truck (the truck being weighed each time before it is loaded), the weight of the loaded truck, and the net weight of the bituminous material. If the material is being measured for payment by the gallon (liter), the specific gravity at 60 °F/60 °F (15.6 °C/15.6 °C) of the bituminous material in the tank truck and the number of gallons (liters) at 60 °F (15.6 °C) shall be shown on the weight ticket.

Cover Coat Aggregate and Seal Coat Aggregate will be measured in tons (metric tons) according to the requirements of Article 311.08(b), except that measurement for payment will not be made for aggregate in excess of 110 percent of the amount specified by the Engineer.

403.16 Basis of Payment. This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per gallon (liter) for BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (PRIME COAT), BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (COVER AND SEAL COATS), and POLYMERIZED BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (COVER AND SEAL COATS); or at the contract unit price per ton (metric ton) for BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (PRIME COAT), BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (COVER AND SEAL COATS), and POLYMERIZED BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (COVER AND SEAL COATS); and per ton (metric ton) for COVER COAT AGGREGATE and SEAL COAT AGGREGATE.

When provided as a payment item, the preparation of the base or existing surface will be measured and paid for as specified in Section 358. If not provided as a payment item, preparation of base or existing surface shall be considered as included in the contract unit price(s) for the bituminous surface treatment.
